Get ready for a summer full of stories, programs, and prizes!

Early Sign-ups open Monday, May 26th but reading officially counts starting June 1st.

Stop by the front desk to get your access code for logging your minutes or books on Readerzone.

Signing up after June 1st? No problem—you can still join anytime! Just remember: your reading only count from the day you sign up onward.

Kids can earn awesome prizes at 100, 300, 600, 900, and 1200 minutes.

DOWNLOAD READER ZONE APP!

If you already have the app, delete and re-install it to make sure it's up to date.

- Create / Login to your Reader's account.
- Visit the library to receive this year's access code.
- Track the minutes you spend reading/listening to books from June 1st - August 2nd to win prizes!

* Reminder: Reading only counts from the day you sign up. (No backlogging).

HELPFUL TIPS

- Reading 20 Minutes a day can win you all 5 prizes!
- Books, Ebooks, Audiobooks, Graphic Novels, & Manga all count.
- Reading aloud to friends & family count for both reader & listener(s).

TRACK YOUR READING VIA **READERZONE APP OR PAPER LOG!**

READERZONE

- Create / Login to your Readerzone account.
- Visit the library to receive this year's access code.
- Track your books on Readerzone and visit the library to enter a raffle for each book you read!

PAPER LOG

- Pick up a paper log from the Library to track your books.
- Bring your log to a librarian throughout the summer to fill out raffle entries for each book you read!

- First 100 readers will receive a Canvas Tote Bag after completing their first book of the summer!
- Raffles will be drawn for prize baskets at the end of June and July.
